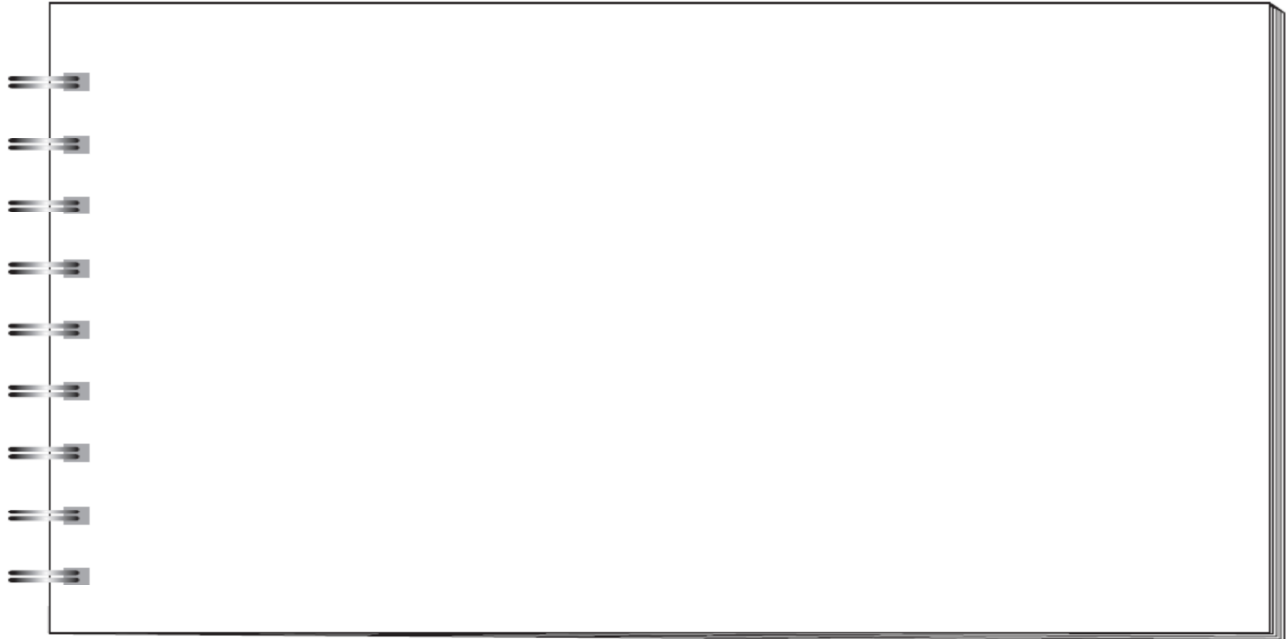

Important points	Unknown words	Confusing grammar	Confusing pronunciation
"You are mortal/ people attending the exhibition can realise their own vulnerability"	<i>Mortal</i> = you will die one day	People attending the exhibition = <i>participle clause e.g. people who are attending the exhibition.</i>	Vulnerability = <i>vunrability</i>
"People attending the exhibition should get a clearer idea of their own bodies"			

"The intention was to present anatomy in a very concrete way"			
"This exhibition is not about art or science, it's about instruction"			

Tip 1: Listen to words you didn't understand a few times and try to note down exactly how they are pronounced.
